# Why GFA BASIC 3 ?

By John Peters

"Why should I upgrade from GFA BASIC 2 to version 3? "This is a question we have been asked a lot. Also "Why should I buy GFA Basic rather than one of the other Basics on the market?" Is another favourite. In an attempt to answer both questions at once here is my opinion of V3 GFA Basic, and why you should buy it.

Firstly to those of you who have already been 'converted' by getting version 2, you already know what a good, easy to use, language GFA Basic is. Those of you who have not used GFA, are sadly missing a very good programming language. The upgrade to version 3 is a must for any serious programmer, beginner or expert, since GFA Basic caters for all tastes.

Simply put, GFA V3 offers about 250 more commands than V2, in many cases reducing many lines of V2 Basic to a single line of V3, has a better editor, runs programs faster, produces smaller code when compiled and has a manual which is probably one of the best 'all round' manuals I have seen for the ST, let alone for Basic!

## Commands.

If you like messing around with GEM, then GFA has commands that are very similar to C. This means that you can read any of the books written for the operating system of the ST (which all have functions written in C because the ST's OS is written in C), and apply these examples to GFA Basic, using the built in commands. A good example of this is the use of resource files in your programs, in V2 you had to do a lot of work with the AES parameter blocks, whereas in V3 you can call the functions directly. eg `RSRC_LOAD("FRED.RSC")` is the command to load the resource file "FRED" and is very similar to the C function. The use of commands extends over VDI, AES the use of ALINE routines etc. You can define the function keys, and there is even a 'logo' type DRAW command subset.

Another great improvement is in the use of bit manipulation, you can use the machine code equivalents or ROR, SHL, BTST etc. Variables can be 6 different types: bit, byte, word, longword, float-point and strings.

You can even use a built in SORT command to sort strings or arrays. There are just too many commands to do the justice here.

## The Editor.

Again, those of you who have used V2 Basic, will be familiar with its very good editor, which owes much of its style to Pascal's structured syntax. V3's editor has been improved, in that it is quicker, has facilities to erase from the cursor to the end of the line and then replace the text into another line. You can now undelete text accidentally Control-Deleted. Then there's the novel, but useful approach of folding procedures, where once you have written a procedure, you can fold it, and all you will see in the listing is

>PROCEDURE followed by it's name. You can trace programs whilst running and direct the trace to any output device. The editor menu has a clock and the facility to use accessories, and of course, none of those horribly slow GEM windows!! You can also link into the GFA Assembler, (when it is released), to produce machine code 'patches' via the instruction `INLINE`. However, until GFA Assembler comes out, `INLINE` is for data storage of such things as screens/images etc. In your Basic program, you just load the data into the `INLINE` area.

## Speed and all the rest.

GFA Basic 3 is about 30% faster than V2 interpreted and about 40% faster when compiled. In some instances GFA Basic is faster than compiled C, and of course the development time is a lot less. You can include compiled C or machine code routines into your Basic code on compiling it. Another plus is that you can now write accessories with V3 and the compiler. GFA Basic is certainly a language to control all aspects of the ST to its full potential, and belies its name Basic. I think it is no longer a basic language, rather a full development tool in its own right.

# More Power For The ST

## A REVIEW OF LDW POWER SPREADSHEET FOR ATARI ST

by Alan Duplex

LDW POWER is a very fast and powerful spreadsheet, a graph maker, a Data Base and includes it's own programming language of macros. But it's best selling feature is it's LOTUS 1.2.3 (release 2) compatibility, so ST owners can exchange files with people less fortunate ( Those that bought IBM's ). And for less than half the price LDW POWER does all that LOTUS can and more!

(Now for the standard reviewers opening line.) LDW has so many features it's hard to know where to start.

(O.K. that's over. Lets start with speed)

LDW is not just fast its really fast, making it possible to leave auto-recalculate mode enabled, even with the most complex sheets. This was never possible with K-Spread 2 as it took several minutes to recalculate a large document. Like all spreadsheets, cells can contain text, values or a formula. LDW is intuitive enough to identify which type you are entering as you type.

92 functions are provided, that can form part of your formulae, including some powerful financial functions like the @DDB function which calculates the depreciation expense of an asset using the accelerated depreciation method of double declining balance. Now that's a mouth full but it does show the power available with the built in functions.

This spreadsheet contains 2,097,152 cells split into columns A to IV and rows 1 to 8192, columns can be between 1 and 126 characters wide. This makes it possible to create very large spreadsheets indeed and to make printing these more readable LDW comes with a special program that allows the sideways printing of files.

LDW lets you open four GEM windows at once plus an extra window for the graph mode (Lotus can only split the display into two) Graph mode lets you make LINE, Bar, XY, Stacked Bar or Pie graphs using any

range or value from your spreadsheet. Graphs can be saved with your spreadsheet or saved separately. In fact all presets are saved with the spreadsheet, even the size and position of all windows, enabling you to pick-up exactly where you left off the next time you load that file, and even this has been made easy, by saving a file as AUTO.LDW it will be loaded as soon as LDW starts up.

As if all this isn't enough LDW can also act as a data base. By setting up some columns as fields and placing your data on the rows below, LDW can then do some very comprehensive query and find operations on your data. If your data (or any other cells in your spreadsheet) are of a sensitive nature LDW provides three ways of protecting them. One is to hide them from being displayed, another is by protecting a cell or range of cells so that they cannot be modified, and for total security each file can have its own pass word and can not be reloaded until the correct pass word is entered.

And last but by no means least LDW has the ability to record and replay Macros. Macros are groups of keystrokes, but as all menu calls have keyboard equivalents, Macros effectively become a programming language letting you automate the operations required on a regular basis.

"Want see the fastest text editor you have ever seen" proud owner and known Atari ST evangelist.

*"Oh yeh sure ....."* unenlightened EyeBeeM owner(loser)

"This a 250k document ok so lets scroll through it line byline and can you time it with your watch"

*"Gee i forgot to bring my calendar....."*

Time passes time passes in fact 1 minute 56 seconds and we have finished. This process is repeated several times much to my amusement.

*"So its pretty good but thats only scrolling..."* (glutton for punishment)

So after 15 - 20 minutes of facial contortion and neanderthalian mating calls a series of questions is now asked.(which only certain owners can ask)

*"What ram and card are you using for the monitor?"*

Chuckle! Chuckle!

*"ok then the chip must be 16+Mhz and co-processed?"*

Chuckle! Chuckle!

*"it must have cost you a packet must be at least 400 - 500 dollars of software"*

The amount of features in Tempus 2 are pretty well boundless what this program cannot do to raw text files is not worth printing. The search and replace is so fast that you never see it happening. The first time I tried this I replaced all the is strings in Your Second Manual to the Atari ST and it seemed as nothing happened and then up came a message 1921 strings found and replaced. This particularly fast and powerful for the programmer who may wish to change a variables name etc, or if like me you read mail echos that often have 200k of message to search through this is the one too use simply type in your keyword press the return key and whammo you have arrived.

Tempus 2 can also switch between the normal sized screen font and the more compact 8 x 8 font hence you have 48 lines to the screen. You may also set your memory parameters, it has an auto save function which you can set the time span and drive path for, a monitor protector that will blank the screen after the set time of inactivity. Function keys can be defined to insert macros of text hence very useful for the programmers. Under the about Tempus info bar you will presented with usual copyright notices plus the present edit files statistics.

The block marking, moving, manipulation and saving is nothing short of fast and brilliant on Tempus 2. Line length can be anywhere from 1 to 255, page length can be up to 999 lines. You can wrap text and unwrap text with consummate ease ( sounds a bit like christmas all this wrapping).

The manual well what can I say comprehensive and very easy to read with graphical help where possible displaying any on screen menu that appears.

There are a plethora of features in Tempus 2 that will satisfy any text maniac ( say it with a lisp). Where could you use this well just about anywhere as a front end to your favourite DTP package, programming language, etc etc. Tempus 2 is a well finished and presented product it is the fastest and most powerful text editor around for anything I have ever seen. In closing I would like to steal an idea from the Remington advert a couple of years ago.

# Thunder from your hard disk

## Modifying THUNDER.ACC to run from Hard Disk By Steve Dunne

One of the limitations of using thunder as an accessory is its insistence on upon loading the configuration file (thacc.cnf) from the A: drive. Interestingly enough the .PRG version of Thunder will load its .cnf file from the current directory or folder thereby allowing it to run from a hard disk without problems.



To modify Thunder you will need a disk editor programme to search for the existing hex sequence and to subsequently enter the new values.

Thunder loads the file name "\thacc.cnf" onto the user stack ready for a GEMDOS call to check that the file exists and to load in the configuration information using a simple block move sequence. Unfortunately, however, it adds the prefix A: from a separate part of the programme which is why you can't just search for a A:\thacc.cnf and change the drive specifier around to suit.

This separate part of the programme takes the form of;

move.b # $\$41$ , $\$-B2(A6)$  ; Where  $\$41$  is the Drive (A)  
move.b # $\$3A$ , $\$-b1(A6)$  ; and the  $\$3A$  is the colon.

To load Thunder from hard disk (say C:) you simply have to modify the drive specifier  $\$41$  to  $\$43$  (or whatever).

1. Search for the HEX sequence 1D 7C 00 41 (move.b # $\$41$ ,)
2. Change the 41 to 43 (for C drive)
3. and save the file back to disk. Simple !!!



Not quite. There are actually two occurrences of the code that needs to be modified. So once you have found the first occurrence, change it and keep searching until you have found the second. On my version of Thunder the HEX sequences are found at the relative addresses  $\$3A7E$  and  $\$3FFE$ .

The only limitations of this modification is that the thacc.cnf file MUST reside in the root directory of the nominated drive. That is you can't copy the .cnf file into a folder.

Once you have made these modifications you can configure Thunder to load all your dictionaries etc directly of hard disk. You can now enjoy the benefits of Thunder with the speed and efficiency of a Hard Disk.

# HiSoft C

## Hisoft C Interpreter review by Craig Valli

Hisoft C unlike other types of C for the Atari is an interpreted language hence the language is now learner friendly why learner friendly simply because it is interpreted that's why. The interpreter is also backed up with a very comprehensive and complete manual as well as extensive on disk help for the novice and expert.



The package is as mentioned interpreted and this may be seen as a problem by some but a great majority of users both novice and expert will find this 'C' interpreter useful in their programming armoury. The acquisition of a compiler for most users can be had at a greater date when you have something worth compiling.

The manual like I mentioned before is very comprehensive (250 pages in fact) and contains a full listing of C commands handled by the interpreter and also has the commands as listed from its source i.e. UNIX, Hisoft C, Ansi etc. The manual also gives a detailed explanation of each command and its resultant output or consequence if any. The manual is complemented very well by the help function in the program itself. By typing in the command that you require help with at the appropriate prompt you will receive a detailed explanation of the command and what it does. The manual also provides you with some help in transporting the code from the Hisoft C interpreter to the main compilers available for the Atari ST as the Hisoft 'C' interpreter is not a full K&R implementation and falls short of the ANSI standard. The manual gives the novice also a very basic grounding in 'C' but also has a bibliography of recommended books that you can acquire, beg, borrow or steal.

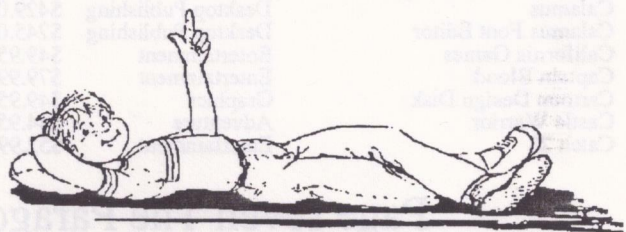
The editor provided with the program is quite useful and is a mini word processor in fact its speed is most impressive. The only set back if any

is that you cannot readily switch between interpreter and editor. It has ample search and replace type facilities. It is fast at scrolling through a document and the search and replace or search facilities are very fast indeed. You can also have up to 8 modules open on the desktop at anytime as well which is very useful indeed.

Why have I recommended this package for the experienced 'C' user seeing as the package is orientated towards the first time user of 'C'. The answer is that not all of us like sitting around for the compiler to run through our code and then several minutes later finding out the error. An interpreter of any sort whether it be for BASIC, APL, ADA, PASCAL etc provides the user with instantaneous feedback as to where their code is going wrong. As well as this obvious advantage there are some features built in Hisoft 'C' that have been made available. The interpreter traps all of the 68000 exceptions hence a bomb less screen. There is a variable dump mode that allows the user to examine variables and their contents after code has been executed. As well as the dump mode there is trace mode that allows the user to view a line before it is executed. Trace can be activated by a drop down menu which remains on for the duration and via software switching which can switch this mode off and on. It is similar in some ways to the TRON from BASIC's I have used.

In conclusion the possible disadvantage of using Hisoft 'C' is that it is not a full K&R implementation and hence using files from other compilers etc may prove slightly cumbersome. However this and the fact that the language is interpreted aside Hisoft 'C' for both novice and competent users provides interesting possibilities and is worth a serious look for addition to your programming powerbox.
