

CHICKEN OUT

CHICKEN OUT is a game of adventure and strategy in which you and an opponent attempt to trap one another as you move strategically across the screen. If the player is sharp, and uses intricate movement patterns, he may be able to surround his opponent in the trail left by his motion. CHICKEN OUT is a game of tactics and wit, requiring concentration and a steady wrist of the player. You also need cool nerves; if you CHICKEN OUT, you could be trapped. CHICKEN OUT . . . A fun-filled video strategy game for two players.

LOADING REQUIREMENTS:

Make sure all hardware is off. Turn on ATARI disk drive, and insert diskette. Make sure JOYSTICKS are connected to CONTROLLER PORTS at the front of the computer.

SCORING:

Cause your opponent to cross your trail 3 times.

HINTS:

JOYSTICKS move men. As man moves, he leaves a trail. The object is to trap your opponent by surrounding him by your trail while avoiding being trapped by his trail. You may cross a trail (yours or his), only twice: 3rd time and you lose.

If a man moves backwards he will cross his own trail and die.
