We do this to save space and give you more programming. You can see the contents of each disk side by booting up Atari DOS and using the 'A' function.

Please note the program names and particularly the extenders. Programs that have the .SAV extender are used with the Basic cartridge installed. Just type: RUN "D:(PROGRAM NAME).SAV.

Programs with the .LST extender also use Basic. For these programs type: ENTER "D:(PROGRAM NAME).LST. Then type RUN when you see the READY prompt.

Programs with the .ODJ extender are used HITHOUT Basic. Boot. DOS without Basic and use function 'L'. When asked for the filename, just type (PROGRAM NAME).OBJ.

The A.M.S. disks have a self-booting Player program on Side A ONLY! You must boot Side A first. To play Side B, boot Side A, and then turn the disk over to play the music files on the 'flip' side.
