

Loading & Running Program

MAGIC STORYBOOK will run on an *Atari 400/800 computer with a minimum of 16K memory. You will also need a 410 cassette recorder and one joystick using the left joystick port #1.

Before you start, make sure that the recorder is connected and the power on your computer is shut off.

1...Place cassette into recorder with side marked "PROGRAM" facing upward.

2...Place recorder into "PLAY" mode.

3...Hold "START" button down on console while turning on computer.

4... After hearing a "BEEP", press "RETURN".

At this point the program will load and run automatically. Loading time is approximately 4 minutes. During MAGIC STORYBOOK you will be asked to move the wolf with the left joystock. This will scroll the program. If the wolf is not moved within a one minute time span, the story will continue automatically.

Rerunning Program

After the story has ended, follow these instructions but **do not** turn off the computer.

#1...Place cassette in recorder with side marked "SOUNDTRACK" facing upward.

2...Rewind tape.

3...Place recorder in "PLAY" mode.

4...Press "START" on computer console.

<u>SPECIAL NOTE...do not</u> press "START" until the recorder is properly cued. This may cause the program to execute out of sync with the sound track.

Amulet has included the script for those parents who would like to read the story to their children. To make the program execute without our sound track simply insert any musical cassette into the recorder and follow "RERUNNING PROGRAM" instructions.
