What is Let's Spell?

Let's Spell is a series of 4 programs. The first three teach a second grade spelling list of 90 words. The fourth program is a test of the 90 words. Each lesson covers 30 words.

All of the programs on this cassette have voice accompaniment.

How To Use Let's Spell

CLOAD the first program and RUN it as you would any Atari BASIC program. However, keep the PLAY button down on the cassette player when you run the program so that the voice track will be played with the program.

The student will be presented with a word and shown how to spell it. Then, in a series of 5 words, the student will have to spell the word from its sound.

Each program lesson has 30 words, but 30 words may be too much to learn in a single session. Have the child do a few words in the beginning, and increase the number at each sitting. Each program must be run from its beginning, so that each learning session will begin with a repeat of the first words in the program.

After several sessions the student should be able to do all thirty words. Do not have the student take the final test until all of the words are mastered.
