# MIGHTY MAIL (README)

# Page 7:

The documentation states that the word Desk on the menu line changes to display the name of the current file. Instead, Desk remains the same, and the filename appears just to the right of the Printer option. Opening the filename's pulldown menu will show how many active records are in the current file.

## Page 17:

The manual says that Insert Mode appears in reverse video. Instead, it appears in normal text.

#### Page 28:

The manual says that the select buttons are labeled 80 COLS and 160 COLS. They are actually labeled 80 and 160 in the program.

## Page 32:

The manual states that Mighty Mail remembers the last mask of each type. It should read that Mighty Mail remembers the last mask (high/low or autotype) for each file. This means that you have separate masks for each file.

### Page 34:

The manual reads "each flag set on in the High mask is changed to off". It should read "each flag set in the high mask is toggled". That is, if the flag was on it is now turned off, or if it was off it is now turned on.

Additions to Mighty MAIL 06/17/86.

The report and label layouts now allow you to change the size of the fields. To change the field sizes, hold down the shift key when you click on the field. You can then "stretch" or "shrink" the field elastically. The field returns to normal size if moved below the line.

The minumum field size is 5 characters. The maximum field size is the length of the original field. Stretching the field beyond the original field length will return the field to that original size. Reducing it to less than 5 characters will cause the program to reset it at the minimum length of 5 characters. If you move or stretch a field, and the result of that operation causes an overlap, the field will remain unchanged. The program uses a "what you see is what you get" algorithm.

For example, if you set the company name length to 10 characters, it will only place 10 characters on the paper. If you place a field directly to the right of that field (touching), the program closes up the space between the fields, combining them together. The program always places at least one space between the two fields when they are printed, even if it has to replace the last character of the company name with a space.

The manual on page 25 is in error. The sequence is as follows:

"Company", "Last", "First", "Address 1", "Address 2", "City", "State", "Zip Code", "Phone", "-Flags-"

The number of flags have been increased to 96. This allows more specific searches, and print outs. To transfer your old data to the new version of Mighty Mail you must first export your old file and then import it back under a new name.

Also, an online help function has been added to access help information for almost any function of the program. This file has been written in a text editor so that you may modify, add, or change the help file to suit your own needs. Be careful to follow the format of the original file. A control-L (^L) signifies a page break.
